

General Terms and Conditions for Participation in the Call for Speakers INTERGEO | INTERAERIAL SOLUTIONS | SMART CITY SOLUTIONS

1. These General Terms and Conditions apply to participation in the call for speakers for INTERGEO | INTERAERIAL SOLUTIONS | SMART CITY SOLUTIONS 2020.
2. Companies/organizations, or rather, their spokespersons, are invited to use the call for speakers process to submit applications to give presentations at INTERGEO | INTERAERIAL SOLUTIONS | SMART CITY SOLUTIONS 2020 on one of the topics in the official list of topics.
3. In order for the organizers to assess the proposed presentation, each applicant must provide the following information in the online call for speakers portal: First name, last name, function, company/organization, presentation title, brief abstract (max. 1.000 characters), biography, planned presentation time (please enter in the message field)
4. Presentation time slot: 15-20 minutes
5. Advertising/sales presentations will not be accepted.
6. The submitted presentation proposals will be assessed by a jury / group of event partners. Each applicant will then be informed via e-mail regarding whether or not his/her presentation has been accepted for inclusion in the forum program.
7. Once a proposed presentation has been accepted, it is not possible for the speaker to retrospectively make substantive changes to the presentation content. Minor updates are possible (via e-mail to cgunesch@hinte-messe.de).
8. Each lecture is charged with a fee of 450,00 €. Invoicing after the event. (Free of charge for research institutions and best practices of cities.) MEET UP sessions are free for research partners and cities, for providers for 750,00 EUR.
9. The speakers agree that their personal data may be stored and processed within the framework of the organisation and implementation of the programmes in accordance with the legal provisions and to the extent necessary. This means that HINTE Messe- und Ausstellungs-GmbH may contact the speaker/participant about the course of the programme planning and in the event of queries regarding content.
10. The speakers agree to the use and publication of information submitted on the lecture and speakers (lecture title, abstract on the lecture, details on the speaker, biography and portrait photo of the speaker) on the Internet and in printed form for the purpose of press and public relations work (in particular for advertising and communication of the event). The data will not be passed on to third parties.
11. The speakers agree that they may be photographed and/or filmed at the event and that these pictures/videos may be stored, used and published in reports on the event, both in printed form and, in particular, online in networks accessible worldwide (the internet) and in so-called social networks (e.g. Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Instagram).
